

Call for evaluation experts for the “Diversity, inequalities and social inclusion” Programme of the EEA Financial Mechanism 2009-2014 Call

Experts are required for the evaluation of proposals to be received from the “Diversity, inequalities and social inclusion”, Programme area “Research within Priority Sectors” of the EEA Financial Mechanism 2009-2014 call.

Experts must have expertise in at least one of the following three areas:

- Local and regional initiatives to reduce national inequalities and to promote social inclusion
- Mainstreaming gender equality and promoting work-life balance
- Promotion of diversity in culture and arts within European Cultural Heritage

Evaluations will commence in late December following the closing of the call. Evaluations will be carried out online in the electronic submission platform available at: <https://apps.gov.gr/minedu/international/research-priorities-2014/>, to which the selected evaluators will be granted access to the proposals they are grading and to an online evaluation form which they will be required to complete for each application assessed.

Each expert is expected to evaluate 7 proposals and each proposal will be evaluated by 2 evaluators covering the area of expertise mentioned above. All evaluators will be required to sign a No Conflict of Interest Declaration. Evaluators will receive remuneration €40 per proposal.
